

## CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR THE UPGRADING PROGRAM (BACHELOR'S DEGREE) IN MIDWIFERY 2021-2022

The College of Medicine and Health Sciences, (University of Rwanda) wishes to recruit applicants for Bachelor of Science with Honors in Midwifery. The program will be full-time with six trimesters. The first trimester starts with the beginning of the academic year 2021-2022. Any candidate willing to apply to follow this program will be recruited as a private (self-sponsored) student according to the University of Rwanda Tuition fees scheme.

## I. **Application requirements**

- 1. Have completed an Advanced Diploma in Midwifery
- 2. Present notified copies of academic transcripts and certificates of Advanced Diploma in Midwifery with an average of 65% of final marks.
- 3. Present a National Council of Nurses and Midwives Registration Certificate and a valid license to practice as A1 Midwife
- 4. Motivation letter (300words) addressed to the principal of College of Medicine and Health Sciences.
- 5. Photocopy of Identity card or passport
- 6. Two white-colored photo passport
- 7. Shortlisted candidates will need to pass an oral exam for selection and will be contacted by the College Registrar's Office about shortlisting-related information.
- 8. Able to study in a program where the English Language is used as a medium of Instruction.
- 9. Agree to comply with the Academic Regulations of the University of Rwanda.



## II. **Application process**

The applicant must complete the following steps and submit all documents to the department of Midwifery CMHS Remera campus by March 18th, 2022.

Before the application, the applicant should make sure that She/he has a student reference number and PIN obtained through the link www.ur.ac.rw of the University of Rwanda. Go to the University of Rwanda website and click on admission at the main menu bar.

Click on "Student Portal"

Log in to the new application on the left side of the page to create the student account.

Complete your personal information and generate a reference number and PIN. Please record your reference number and PIN.

After generating a reference number, pay a non-refundable fee of Frw 5000 for (Rwandan and EAC citizens) and Frw 6000 for International applicants to University of Rwanda Account number 0009400651934-37 Bank of Kigali.

Notice: For graduates who completed in the University of Rwanda, will use the reference number on their transcripts and pay the application fee directly to the bank.
