Short description of the services tendered:

The EAC (East African Community) intends to promote regional initiatives to improve global health care. Health supply chain management has been identified as one key component for improving the situation of many decentralized health centres. In that framework the EAC has established a Regional Centre of Excellence for Vaccines, Immunization and Health Supply Chain Management (RCE-VIHSCM) to foster these competences. The Centre provides educational facilities for health supply chain management and serves as a focal point for best practice and dissemination of innovation and approved procedures.

In cooperation with the German Development Bank (KfW) and the University of Rwanda (UR), College of Medicine and Health Sciences, School of Public Health, it is intended to finance a tuition building and related equipment for the RCE-VIHSCM.

The estimated overall budget for the infrastructure component is about 4.000.000 EUR. The project duration is 3 years.

The contract will be awarded to an independent consultant firm /consortium with proven experience in managing similar construction projects and with a minimum average turnover of 1 million EUR over the last 3 years.
