Duties of a research assistant

- To aliquot, label, transport, and store collected samples in appropriate conditions
- To transport and store samples
- To work closely and provide report to the principal investigator

- The research assistant must have a bachelor's degree in biomedical laboratory sciences and or with a master's degree in any medical-related field
- Applicant must be UR/CMHS staff
