CALL FOR APPLICATIONS TO STUDY MASTER PROGRAMS IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (MBA) ACADEMIC YEAR 2023 April Intake

The University of Rwanda, College of Business and Economics, School of Business is offering the Master of Business Administration (MBA) in all campuses with the following specializations:

- Finance,
- Project Management,
- Human Resource Management,
- Marketing Management
- Banking, and
- Insurance Management

Note that Rusizi, Nyagatare and Huye campuses are only for weekend and Gikondo Campus is only for Evening.

The duration of the programs is 4 semesters (24 months). The first two semesters are dedicated to common modules; the third is for specialized modules and the final for research and thesis writing. The possible extension is of one semester (6 months) maximum.

I. Entry requirements

- 1. An Upper- or lower-Class Honours Undergraduate Degree, or equivalent.
- 2. Computer literacy is essential.
- 3. Good command of the English Language is compulsory;
- 4. For further details on minimum admission requirements, refer to the UR policy for Postgraduate programs.

II. Closing date for applications

Closing of online application process is 15th March 2023

III. Required documents for application

- 1. A cover letter indicating for which program of study the application is being made and description of the motivation to join the program
- 2. Detailed curriculum vitae
- 3. Notarized degree or equivalent from HEC, for degrees acquired out side of Rwanda.
- 4. Notarized academic transcripts

- Two recommendation letters from academic referees who are knowledgeable about the applicant,
- 6. Copy of national identity card or Passport
